- 1. OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

#### 2. Generic

Option Clause: Excess Settlement. The excess settlement has been enabled for the service, allowing service providers to include additional charges up to a specified percentage of the item-level total value, including addons, in their invoices. Service providers must declare the applicability of additional charges during invoice creation and submit mandatory supporting documents to avail this option. The total invoice amount, including additional charges, shall not exceed the agreed-upon excess settlement percentage for the order.

- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

#### **Preamble**

## Section 1- Commitments of the Principal

1. The Principal commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles: - a) No employee of the Principal, personally or through family members, will in connection with the tender for or the execution of a contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to. b) The Principal will, during the lender process treat all Bidder(S) with equity and reason. The principal will in particular, before and during the tender process, provide to all Bidder(S) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(S) confidential/additional information through which the Bidder(S) could obtain an advantage in relation to the tender process or the contract execution. c) The Principal will exclude from the process all known prejudiced persons. 2. If the Principal obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the IPC/PC Act, or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can initiate disciplinary actions.

## Section 2- Commitments of the Bidder(S)/contractor(S)

1. The Bidder(S)/Contractor(S) commit themselves to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the tender process and during the contract execution. a) The Bidder(S)/Contractor(S) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal's employees involved in the tender processor the execution of the contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind

This applies in particular to process, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelisation in the bidding process. c) The Bidder(S/Contractor(S) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act; further the bidder(S)/contractor(S) will not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on too other, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically. d) The Bidder(S)/Contractors(S) of foreign origin shall disclose the name andaddress of the Agents/representatives in India, if any. Similarly, the Bidder(S)/Contractors(S) of Indian Nationality shall furnish the name and address of the foreign principals, if any. Further details as mentioned in the "Guidelines on Indian Agents of Foreign Suppliers" shall be disclosed by the Bidder(S)/Contractors(S). Further, as mentioned in the Guidelines all the payments made to the Indian agent/representative have to be in Indian Rupees only. Copy of the "Guidelines on Indian Agents of Foreign Suppliers' is placed at Annexure-B1. e) The Bidder(S)/Contractor(S) will, when presentinghis bid, disclose any and all payments he has made is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract. 13 2. The Bidder(S)/Contractor(S) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

#### Section 3- Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts.

If the Bidder(S)/Contractor(S), before award or during the execution has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2, above or in any other form such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidder(S)/Contractor(S) from the tender process or take action as per the procedure mentioned in the "Guidelines on Banning of Business Dealings". Copy of the "Guidelines on Banning of Business Dealings" is annexed and marked as Annexure-B2.

#### **Section 4- Compensation for Damages**

1. If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(S) from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3, the principal is entitled to demand and recover the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/Bid Security. 2. If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor liquidated damages of the Contract value or the amount equivalent to Performance Bank Guarantee.



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**Section 5- Previous transgression** 

1. The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last three years with any other Company in any county conforming to the anti-corruption approach or with any other Public Sector Enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process. 2. If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process or action can be taken as per the procedure mentioned in "Guidelines on Banning of Business Dealing."

The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from his subcontractor a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. 2. The Principal will enter into agreements with identical condition as this one with all Bidders and Contractors. 3. The Principal will disqualify from the tender process all bidders who do not sing this pact or violateits provisions.

Section

7 - Criminal charge against violating Bidder (s) /contractor(s) /subcontractor(s)

If the Principal obtains knowledge of conduct of Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor which constitutes corruption, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will informthe same to the chief vigilance officer.

## Section 8 - Independent External Monitor/Monitors

1. The Principal appoints competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this Pact. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent parties comply with the obligation under this agreement. 2. The Monitor is notsubject to instruction by the representatives of the parties and performs his function neutrally and independently. It will be obligatory for him to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/Contractors as confidential. He report to the chairman, NTC

3. The Bidder(s)/contractor(s) accepts that the monitor has the rightto access without Restriction to all project documentation of the principal including that provided by the Contractor. The contractor will also grant the monitor, upon his request and Demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his project documentation. The same is applicable to subcontractors. The monitor is under Contractual obligation to treat the information and document of the Bidder(s)/contractor(s)/subcontractor (8) with confidentiality. 4. The principal will



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Provide to the monitor sufficient information about all meeting among the parties related to the project provided such meeting could have an impact on the Contractual relation between the principal and the contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings. 14 5. As soon as the Monitor notices,

or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of the principal and request the Management to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The monitor can in this regard submit nonbinding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action. 6. The Monitor will submit a written report to the Chairman, NTC within 8 to 10 weeks from the date or intimation to him by the principal and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations. 7. If the Monitor has reported to the Chairman, NTC, a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant IPC/PC Act, and the Chairman NTC has not, within the reasonable time taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Chief Vigilance Officer, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner. 8. The word 'Monitor' would include both singular and plural. Monitor would be entitled to receive such compensation as may be decided time to time by the CMD/Competent Authority.

- 2. INDEPENDENT EXTERNAL MONITORS NTC has appointed Smt. Seema Bahuguna, IAS (Retd), and Shri Vijay Anand, IRS (Retd.) as Independent External Monitors (IEMs), with the approval of Chief Vigilance Commission for implementation of Integrity Pact. IEMs commenced their services to the Company.

## **Section 9-Pact Duration**

This Pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires forthe Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the contract or contract period (extended if applicable) whichever is later and for all other Bidders 6 months after the contract has been awarded.

If any claim is made / lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this past as specified above, unless it is discharge/determined by Chairman of NTC.



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#### Section 10- Other provisions

- 1. This agreement is subject to Indian Law. Place of performance and jurisdiction is the Registered Office of the Principal, i.e. New Delhi
- 2. Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- 3. If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement mustbe signed by all partners or consortium members
- 4. Should one or several provisions of this agreement turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this agreement remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
